The Volcanic Loire wine-growing area is located in the heart of the Massif Central and is characterised by granitic or basaltic soils with a certain acidity, an exceptional climate partly due to the foehn effect, vines planted at altitudes of between 200 and 600 metres which ensures optimum ripening of the grapes, and a grape variety common to all the wine-growers, namely Gamay.

### 2 vineyards in the Loire Volcanique Côte Roannaise & Vignoble du Forez

An AOC (Appellation d'Origine Contrôlée) since 1994, the Côte Roannaise is situated in the north of the Loire department and covers some twenty kilometres and 14 communes, and culminates at an altitude of 550 metres. The Gamay grape reigns supreme on these **granite slopes**. The Gamay Saint-Romain is particularly present as it is this grape variety which is native to the area and consequently shapes the identity and the wines in the appellation.

The Roanne area, so dear to Pierre Troisgros, is a land of gastronomy and its granite soils give a very special quality to the Gamay Saint-Romain grape variety. The terroir is full of refinement, which is reflected in the fragrant, fresh wines.















Les Côtes du Forez is the vineyard located the furthest upriver in the Loire Valley. It is nestled in the heart of the Loire department on the lower volcanic slopes of the Massif Central, just *a* stone's throw from St-Étienne and 100 km from Lyon. An AOC (Appellation d'Origine Contrôlée) since 2000, the vineyard now covers almost

150 hectares across 17 communes.

There are two types of soil in this area: **basaltic** mounds of volcanic origin from the oldest volcanoes in France and a granitic **terroir** resulting from the erosion of the Massif Central.

The route along the river Lignon will then take you to the legendary estate of La Bâtie d'Urfé. On the way back, you can enjoy another view of the volcanic mound which forms Mont d'Uzore.

This château, built at the end of the 18th century in a neo-classical style and listed as a Historic Monument, has an imposing façade overlooking an ornamental garden. It houses the Forez Winegrowers' Museum, which showcases a collection retracing the lives of winegrowers.

### Out and about

BETWEEN RUILLAT AND PRALONG
11.8 MI - CHAMPDIEU

This route takes you between the peaks, valleys and plains of Forez along the Ruillat and Pralong streams, where you can discover the rural (dovecote, vineyards) and cultural (11th-century priory) heritage of Champdieu, a designated 'Village de Caractère'.

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### LA MADONE - 5 MI

This short walk allows you to explore the higher parts of Champdieu. Discover the rural heritage of this 'Village de Caractère' and its church and priory. This 8 km hike enables you to admire the view from the Pic de Purchon.



### A must-see



Village de Caractère en Loire' - Champdieu

Champdieu owes all of its character to its medieval origins. The village was built nestling between the hills and the plain, under the protection of the walls of its priory and in the shadow of the two steeples of its church.

**Priory** - Champdieu

This priory is a monastic complex which was built from the 11th century onwards. Rich in sculpted capitals, the church is notable for its 11th-century partially buried crypt.



Centre de l'Art Roman en Forez - Champdieu

This centre for Romanesque art combines rigorous scientific discussion, audio-visual installations and hands-on games.

Salle héraldique de la Diana - Montbrison This room, with its ceiling decorated with 1,728 coats of arms, is unique in France. It houses a library with 30,000 books.



Collégiale Notre Dame d'Espérance - Montbrison The Collégiale Notre-Dame is the most iconic building in Forez. It has unique Gothic architecture and over eight centuries of history.

IN THE VICINITY OF THE PRIORY -9.9 MI ST-ROMAIN-LE-PUY

The route takes you through the Plaine du Forez, with its racehorse stud farms and restored farmhouses. The second, wilder half of the route takes you back along the Forez canal. You will have views of the Pic de St-Romain the whole way round.

#### \*\* THE MONTCLARET ROUTE- 3.7 MI ST-GEORGES-HAUTE-VILLE

Still on the hillsides (but already in the volcanoes), a few acres of vines grow on the basaltic soil. Explore this path, which will show you everything about the geological history of the area and which has beautiful views over a working quarry.

### THE MONSUPT PATH - 8.7 MI ST-GEORGES-HAUTE-VILLE

Follow in the footsteps of the pilgrims on their way to Santiago de Compostela, many of whom stopped off at Montsupt amidst the plains and footbills of Forez.

### A must-see



#### Chapelle St.- / Marie-Madeleine

St-Georges-Haute-Ville
This chapel, perched on
a basalt hillock, is a fine
example of a 12th-century
Romanesque chapel. The
18th-century frescoes in
the chancel are well worth
seeing.



#### Priory

St-Romain-la-Motte

This singular and enigmatic priory sits atop a volcanic cone, where Mediterranean flora (fig, aniseed and almond trees) flourish in the summer months. It overlooks the plain and proudly retains the traces of its past splendour.

**BOISSET-ST-PRIEST** 

This demanding route takes in picturesque villages before winding its way through the steep valleys of the Mare. Beautiful views of the Pic de Monsupt and the Forez plain await visitors taking a short break.

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#### THE LODGES - 13.6 MI ST-MARCELLIN-EN-FOREZ

On this route, you can discover the old lodges which were used by market-gardeners and winegrowers.

#### Pont du Diable

St-Marcellin-en-Forez

Despite the many perils the village of St-Marcellin-en-Forez has had to face, it is still home to architectural treasures such as the Pont du Diable (Devil's Bridge), which has been a listed historic monument since 1921. It is one of the best-preserved bridges in Forez.



#### **Bourg Castral**

St-Marcellin-en-Forez
A former castellany of the
Counts of Forez, St-Marcellin-en-Forez has preserved
the imposing remains of its
ramparts. The old village
which grew up around the
church is concentrated in
the area they enclosed.
